



The stunning view of Matsushima Bay from the summit of Otakamori on Miyato Island Miyato Island is located in the southern part of Higashi-Matsushima, and is part of an area known as "Oku-Matsushi

Selected as One of the Green Destinations Top 100 Stories

In September 2022, Higashi-Matsushima became the first city in Miyagi Prefecture to be selected as one of the Green Destinations Top 100 Stories, chosen by Green Destinations, an international certification body for sustainable tourism based in the Netherlands.

The city's efforts, such as the development of the Miyagi Olle Oku-Matsushima Course with collaboration between the public and private sectors, were recognized for meeting 15 international standards.





Best Tourism Village Certification

In October 2023, Oku-Matsushima was recognized as the first area in the Tohoku region to be a certified as Best Tourism Village (BTV) by UN Tourism (Spain), a United Nations agency promoting sustainable tourism.

The region's efforts in nine areas, including the promotion and preservation of cultural resources, and sustainability in the economic, social, and environmental fields, were highly evaluated.

Famous as one of the Three Views of Japan, Matsushima Bay offers not only stunning scenery, but also a wealth of natural beauty, providing various delights in gourmet cuisine, outdoor activities and more.

And when you delve into the stories of the people who have lived in this bay since ancient times, its allure deepens even further.

In 2018, Higashi-Matsushima was chosen as one of 29 municipalities nationwide as an SDGs Future City by the Cabinet Office.



In 2022, Higashi-Matsushima was chosen as a Decarbonization Leading Area by the national government. The city is promoting regional revitalization by using local resources to produce and consume renewable energy locally.





Hike the Tohoku Coast.

The Michinoku Coastal Trail is a long-distance trail spanning 1,000 km along the Pacific coast from Aomori Prefecture to Fukushima Prefecture, with part of it passing through the coastline of Higashi-Matsushima.

The greatest attraction of this trail is the abundance of dynamic coastal scenery. Along the Higashi-Matsushima section, you can see the Japan Air Self-Defense Force, Matsushima Air Base, home of the famous Blue Impulse acrobatic flight team, as well as enjoy the

stunning views of Matsushima Bay by boat from Oku-Matsushima to the Urato Islands.

Leisurely Explore Higashi-Matsushima

"Olle" is a term for walking tours that originated on Jeju Island, South Korea. Olle is a word from the Jeju dialect, meaning "a narrow path that connects the street to a house," and it has become synonymous with trekking courses. The appeal of Olle lies in enjoying walking while feeling close to nature, such as coastlines and mountains.

Among the five Olle courses in Miyagi Prefecture, the Oku-Matsushima course takes you on a journey around Miyato Island, where you can experience both the history of the Jomon period and the surrounding natural beauty.

Insider tips from a veteran captain /

Here's what to look out for!



Taking a pleasure boat is the best way to fully experience the wonders of Sagakei. The boat is small, so you are close to the sea, and you can see the rock face

Uniquely Shaped Small Islands

The beautiful white rocks of Sagakei are scattered throughout the area. Some of the rocks resemble interesting shapes, like a turtle's face or an elephant's trunk, making them perfect for photo opportunities. In some places, erosion has created mysterious cave-like

Flowers Blooming on the Rocky Surfaces Are a Highlight in Early Summer

If you get close to the rocks by boat and look carefully, you may spot small flowers blooming on the rock surfaces. These are "Sekkoku," an epiphytic orchid, and their blooming season is from late May to early June. Wild varieties of this plant have become quite rare nowadays.






